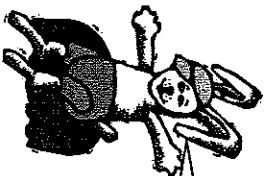
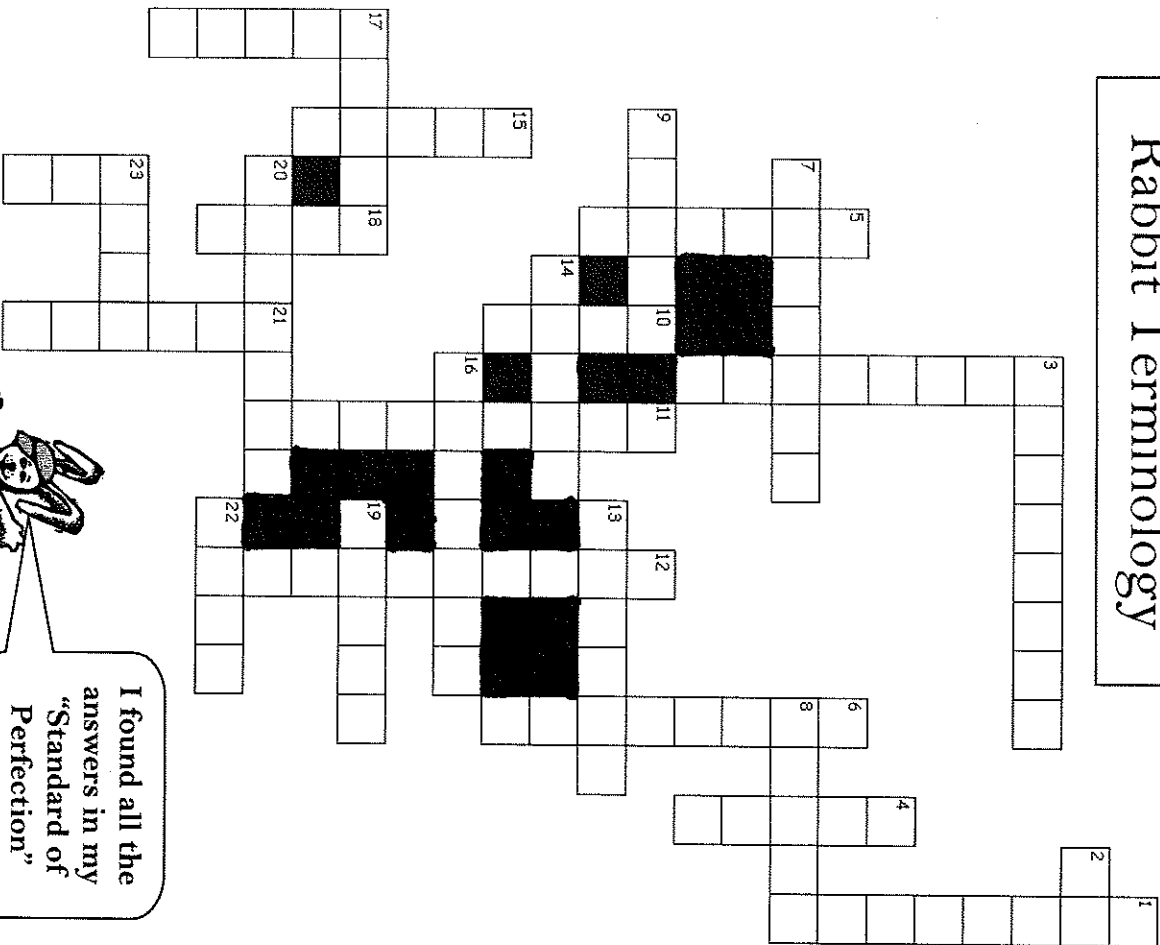


Rabbit Terminology

13. A pendulous fold of loose skin that hangs from the throat
14. The colored markings on the feet and legs of Pointed pattern rabbits
16. The property or quality of a thick coat of fur
17. A class of domestic rabbits that reproduces itself with distinctive characteristics
19. The white marking found on the face of a Dutch
20. An eye that is whitish on the surface (two words)
22. Word used for a hard, brittle tail due to loss of circulation
