WSRBA NATIONAL TEAMS CO-CHAIR JOB DESCRIPTIONS.

1. Organize and lead your committee each year. Submit a list of committee members to the WSRBA Board Secretary at the beginning of the year.
2. Gain the support of many WSRBA members to carry out program activities.
3. Communicate effectively with youth participants and their parents.
4. Communicate effectively with the Board to keep them informed. Utilize the National Teams/Royalty Board Liaison to keep communication open.
5. Coordinate and implement individual and group learning activities for the program all year long with the main purpose of preparing youth for state and national competition.
6. Develop and manage contests at the WSRBA State Convention.
7. Be accountable to get teams/individuals entered in state or national competitions. Meet all deadlines.
8. Make sure that at least one adult is present and accountable for the youth at all activities, to include the learning activities during the year and the state and national competitions. Make sure the youth, parents, and Board Liaisons know who the adult supervisors are for each activity. This is especially important if it is not one of the Chairs.
9. Uphold the integrity of the programs with fair/friendly/fun competition.
10. Uphold the integrity of the programs with true and accurate information.
11. Provide leadership and assistance to volunteers administering the activities.
12. Utilize the assistance of the WSRBA National Teams/Royalty Liaison when needed.
13. At the January WSRBA Board Meeting, provide the Board with an evaluation of the program and offer suggestions for improvement. This can be done through the Committee Chairperson and/or the Board Liaison for each respective committee.
14. Keep the National Teams/Royalty Rules Section of the Constitution up to date.
15. Submit a budget at 2nd meeting of the WSRBA Board.
16. Showmanship Judge for the two lower age brackets can be under 21 years of age; however, the judge for the two older age brackets must be 21 years of age or older.
